Arunachal Assembly approves bill to establish two new districts

The Arunachal Pradesh assembly unanimously approved the creation of two new districts in the western and southern regions of the state during its session. The assembly passed the Arunachal Pradesh (Re-Organisation of Districts) Amendment Bill, 2024, by voice vote facilitating the establishment of Keyi Panyor and **Bichom** districts.

This legislative move brings the total number of districts in the state to 28.

Keyi Panyor district, boasting a population exceeding 30,000 inhabitants across 195 villages, will be delineated from the Lower Subansiri district. Its administrative center will be situated in Yachuli, specifically within the Ter Gapin-Sam Sath area.

Similarly, Bichom district is slated to be formed from territories of East Kameng and West Kameng districts, with Napangphung designated as its principal district

headquarters.

The state cabinet, on February 5, granted its consent for the establishment of these two districts, aiming to streamline administrative processes for improved governance.

New species of Begonia found in Ziro Valley

A new species of Begonia has been found in Arunachal Pradesh, with just two populations in Ziro Valley.

Begonia are flowering plants known for their colourful and diverse foliage.

They belong to the Begoniaceae family and are popular as indoor and outdoor ornamental plants.

□<u>Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar to visit Arunachal on Feb 20</u>


- Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar is set to arrive in Itanagar on February 20 for a two-day state trip.
- Official sources confirm Dhankhar's participation in the 38th Statehood Day celebrations at Indira Gandhi Park in Itanagar.

☐ Arunachal inks pact to set up Special Tiger Protection Force

- Arunachal Pradesh govt recently signed an MoU with National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) to establish the state's first Special Tiger Protection Force, boosting conservation.
- This move aims to bolster conservation efforts and protect the tiger population within the state.
- Arunachal Pradesh, known for its biodiversity, is home to three tiger reserves: Namdapha, Kamlang, and Pakke.
- The primary mandate of the STPF will be to safeguard the assets of the Environment, Forest, and Climate Change department, particularly within the tiger reserves.
- This includes preventing poaching activities targeting tigers and other wildlife species.
- By enhancing surveillance and enforcement, the force aims to curb illegal activities posing threats to the region's biodiversity.

OIL signs agreement for earth science studies in Arunachal, NE region

- State-owned enterprise OIL (Oil India Limited), the National Center for Seismology (NCS) under the Ministry of Earth Sciences, and the Centre for Earth Sciences and Himalayan Studies Govt of Arunachal Pradesh signed a tripartite MoU here to conduct applied earth science studies in India, focusing on Arunachal Pradesh and the Northeast Region.
- He signing ceremony was held on Sunday in the presence of Union Minister of Earth Sciences, Kiren Rijiju, cabinet ministers, senior officials of the Arunachal government and OIL chairman & managing director Ranjit Rath, among others.
- Rijiju also inaugurated the Daporijo Permanent Seismological Observatory and the Heliport Aviation Weather Observing System for the Northeast region.
- He also laid the foundation stone for 2 Doppler Weather Radars for Western and Eastern Arunachal, enhancing the state's weather prediction capabilities.
- The Daporijo Permanent Seismic Station is the 9th in Arunachal and the 160th station in India. It will monitor earthquake activities in the region, as the state falls under active seismic Zone V.
- The Heliport Observing Weather Station for the North East Region has been installed at eleven stations, eight of which are in Arunachal, with one each in Nagaland, Meghalaya, and Mizoram.

□ Arunachal receives 18 GI certificates for unique products

- The Geographical Indication Registry bestowed GI (Geographical Indication) certificates upon 18 distinctive products originating from the picturesque landscapes of Arunachal Pradesh.
- The recognized Arunachal GI products include Khaw Tai (Khamti Rice), Apatani Textile, Yak Churpi, Tangsa Textile, Monpa Textile, Adi Kekir (Ginger), Handmade Carpet, Monpa Handmade Paper, Nyishi Textile Products, Wancho Wooden Craft, Adi Textile, Galo Textile, Singpho Phalap (Singpho Tea), Adi Apong, Arunachal Pradesh Dao (Sword), Annyat Millet, Marua Apo (Marua Millet Beverage), and Khamti Handloom Textile.
- The award ceremony, held on the sidelines of the State Folk Music & Dance Festival, saw Damodar Mishra, General Manager of NABARD, congratulating the recipients and ensuring continued support from the bank for future GI initiatives.
- Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein, who handed over the Arunachal GI certificates, praised NABARD's initiative, emphasizing its integral role in rural development activities within the state.

☐ Assam Govt set to introduce bill to end polygamy in state

 The Assam government is likely to introduce a Bill in the state assembly in December to ban polygamy.

- Polygamy is the practice of marrying more than one person (multiple spouses).

□ Confederation of International Small Tea Holders' HQ shifts to India

- The headquarters of Confederation of International Tea Smallholders (CITS) have been shifted to India from China for the next four years which is a big achievement for small tea holders.
- The decision was taken by FAO IGG on Tea at its 25th session in Guwahati.
- The CITS was established at the 22nd session of FAO IGG on Tea in 2016 to provide a forum for the development of policies and solutions to strengthen the global tea smallholder sector by acting as a convener, catalyst and source of reference, to improve the consistency of tea policy-making on a global level.
- CITS was launched to include the consumer countries and get full support from all

stakeholders and value chains, from the field to the cup.

- Fehujali, produced by Assam DGP, wins best docu award at Jaipur Int'l Festival
- The film 'Fehujali' directed by Dr Partha Sarathi Mahanta who is currently posted as the DIG of Special Task Force of Assam police, has clinched the Best Short Documentary Award at the Best Short Documentary Award.
- The documentary delves into the plight of underprivileged youths in the state, targeted by extremist groups as potential recruits through various coercive tactics, including the lure of money.



☐ Assam's 'Kaji Nemu' attains title of state fruit

- Assam's unique citrus gem, the Kaji Nemu, has officially been declared the State fruit by the state government.

- This announcement, made by Agriculture Minister Atul Bora on Tuesday, recognizes the cultural and economic significance of this regionally-specific lemon variety.

- Kaji Nemu, also known scientifically as **Citrus Limon**, stands out from the ordinary lemon with its oval shape, distinct aroma, and exceptional juiciness.

- Awarded the prestigious **Geographical Indication (GI)** status in 2019, this fruit holds deep cultural significance in Assam and other parts of the Northeast region.

- Minister Bora highlighted the unique characteristic of its **year-round fruit production**, with two peak seasons, making it a valuable source of income for farmers.

☐Guwahati set to host first Future Skills Summit 2024

- The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), in collaboration with the National Institute of Electronics and IT (NIELIT), is set to host the Future Skills Summit in Guwahati today.

- The event will be inaugurated by Union Minister of State for Electronics and IT, Rajeev Chandrasekhar.

- The Summit aims to bring together young Indians, thought leaders, industry experts, policymakers, educators, and technology enthusiasts to discuss strategies for catalyzing future-ready talent for India and the world.

- The Summit will focus on the impact of rapid digitization globally, emphasizing new opportunities for young Indians in cutting-edge technologies such as Artificial Intelligence (AI), Machine Learning (ML), Semiconductors, Robotics, and Cybersecurity.

- These advancements offer significant prospects for the country's youth.





□Tata to invest ₹25,000 crore in Assam semiconductor plant:

- Assam will soon have a ₹25,000 crore semiconductor packaging plant which will be established in partnership with the Assam government and Tata Group, minister of state for electronics and IT Rajeev Chandrasekhar said at the Future Skills Summit in Guwahati.
- The government has earmarked ₹76,000 crore as a financial assistance scheme to attract semiconductor fabrication and packaging units to come up in the country.
- The first investment under the scheme has been done by US-based Micron Technology, which has begun setting up its ATMP unit in Sanand, Gujarat.
- The plant will entail an investment of \$2.75 billion, \$800 million of which will be pumped in by Micron and the rest split between central and state governments.
- The first packaged chip from the unit is expected by December 2024.

☐Mission Basundhara:

- Mission Basundhara is a flagship program launched on 2nd October 2021 by the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, Govt. of Assam.
- Under the leadership of chief minister of Assam, "Mission Basundhara" has been developed in a bid to streamline and resolve and to make land revenue services more accessible to citizens.
- At a programme organised by the Revenue and Disaster Management Department in Guwahati on Saturday, Assam Chief Minister **Himanta Biswa Sarma** inaugurated 'Mission Basundhara.'
- According to him, the objective is a critical step toward simplifying land revenue services and providing simple access to the public for land-related tasks.

- Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Guwahati has launched the largest Remote Pilot Training Organisation (RPTO) in the country with an aim to promote the advancement of drone technology.
- The RPTO has been launched in collaboration with EduRade.
- The Pilot Training Organisation spans across 18 acres and has the capability to fly 9 medium-class drones simultaneously.
- The RPTO will initially introduce a DGCA-Certified Medium Class Drone Pilot Training Course which is tailored to enhance the skills of youth in North East and other regions of India.
- It will also cater specifically to women from self-help groups (SHGs) engaged in agriculture, identified under the Namo Drone Didi Yojna.

☐ Thai filmmaker to adapt Manipuri short film 'It's Not My Choice'

- Manipuri film 'It's not my choice' becomes the first Indian short film to be adapted into Thai.
- The highly acclaimed 2015 Manipuri short film "IT'S NOT MY CHOICE," written and directed by prominent Manipuri actor and filmmaker Priyakanta Laishram, which shed light on transgender issues and featured Miss International Queen India 2016, Bishesh Huirem, has caught the attention of Thai filmmaker Tim Chaiyasing.
- Chaiyasing, a newcomer to the industry, is set to adapt the film into Thai, making it the first-ever Indian short film to be officially adapted into the Thai language.

☐ Manipur: Honda India Foundation's 'Project Buniyaad' launched

- This award is a testament to his exceptional dedication and contribution to the Indian Army and the sport of weightlifting.







□<u>Venuzo Dawhuo retains Chakhesang wrestling title for fourth</u> time




□ Nagaland wins 40+ men's football at National Masters Games

- The Chief Minister's Universal Life Insurance Scheme will be fully funded by the state government.



□ Sikkim restores Old Pension System for govt employees

- As reported, Sikkim now stands as the first state in the Northeast to implement this significant decision.

□ Agartala-Deoghar Express upgraded to modern LHB coaches

- The coaches of train No. 15626/15625 (Agartala-Deoghar-Agartala) weekly express has been converted into modern LHB (Linke Hofmann Busch) coaches, equipped with the-state-of-art features.
- Enroute, the train will run via Ambassa, Badarpur Jn., Lumding Jn., Guwahati, Rangiya Jn., New Jalpaiguri, Naugachia, Bhagalpur etc.
- Conversion of this train to LHB rake will provide comfort to the enroute passengers from northeast who visit to the holy city Deoghar for pilgrimage.

□ Tripura CM launches scheme ensuring universal health cover

- Tripura becomes first among small states introducing a universal healthcare scheme for all.
- CM Jan Arogya Yojana (CMJAY), a universal health insurance scheme, providing free healthcare services to indoor patients up to primary health centre level and empaneled private hospitals in Tripura and outside.
- The scheme covers government employees and 5.12 lakh families with a coverage of Rs 5 lakh per annum.





□ Artists from 4 countries to perform in Tripura Int'l Puppet Festival

 Puppet theater groups from the US, Brazil, Spain and Bangladesh and six groups from Delhi, Rajasthan, West Bengal and host Tripura are participating in the three day festival.

- The International Puppet Festival is being organised as part of the 50 years

celebration of Tripura Puppet Theater.

- The festival is named "TIPU" which stands for "Tripura International Puppet Utsav 2024". Apart from that, groups of puppeteers are also arriving from the USA, Brazil, Bangladesh, and other parts of the country to showcase their art at the festival.



□'Kokborok'

- The Kokborok is a language of Borok people who are geographically known as Tripuris.
- It is one of the state languages of Tripura notified on January 19, 1979.
- The TTAADC has declared the Kokborok as official language of TTAADC on April 20, 1999.
- The Borok or Tripuris are inhabited not only in Tripura state but also in North-Eastern states, Pithoragarh of Uttaranchal and neighboring countries like Bangladesh, Myanmar, Nepal and Bhutan comprising about 1.5 million in numbers.
- The Borok or Tripuris are the branch of Boro people of Assam belonging to the Sino-Tibetan linguistic group and racially Mongoloids.
