ARUNACHAL PRADESH

□ Arunachal Pradesh CM inaugurates 26th district- Keyi Panyor

- Arunachal Pradesh Chief Minister Pema Khandu fulfilled his promise made in September 2023 by inaugurating the state's **26th district**, *Keyi Panyor*, in Yachuli on Friday.
- The new district, carved out of **Lower Subansiri**, will have its headquarters at **Ter Gapin Sam Sarth** area near here.
- Union Minister for Earth Science Kiren Rijiju, Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein, MPs Tapir Gao and Nabam Rebia, along with several cabinet colleagues and local representatives, were also present at the event.
- ☐ Idu Mishmi protect ancestral land through community conservation
- In June 2022, members of the Idu Mishmi community of Elopa and Etugu villages, Dibang valley, declared 70 square kilometres of their ancestral customary land as a community conserved area (CCA).
- This CCA serves as a way for the clans to protect the land, wildlife and cultural traditions from being threatened by deforestation and large hydroelectric projects along the Dibang river.
- It also provides employment for the indigenous youth, who work as rangers and guides for tourists.





□ New flowering plant 'Begonia naraharii' discovered in Arunachal

- Researchers from the University of Science and Technology Meghalaya (USTM), in collaboration with researchers from CSIR-Northeast Institute of Science and Technology, Jorhat, have recently uncovered and delineated a new flowering plant christened "Begonia naraharii B. Hajong, N. Bhat & P. Bharali".
- This breakthrough occurred in the Lohit district of Arunachal Pradesh.

□ Arunachal: CM Pema Khandu inaugurates 27th district- Bichom

- Arunachal Pradesh Chief Minister Pema Khandu in the presence of Union Minister for Earth Science Kiren Rijiju inaugurated the newly formed *Bichom* district on Thursday.
- **Bichom**, the **27th district** of the state, has been carved out of the West Kameng and East Kameng districts.
- The Arunachal Pradesh assembly on Thursday passed a bill by voice vote to create two new districts in the western and southern parts of the state.
- ➤ Chief Minister Pema Khandu introduced the Arunachal Pradesh (Re-Organisation of Districts) Amendment Bill, 2024 which paved the way for the creation of Keyi Panor and Bichom districts. With these, the total number of districts rose to 28.





☐ Arunachal athlete wins gold at Russian Moscow Stars Int'l Wushu C'ship

- Arunachal Pradesh athlete *Laatwang Kamhua* secured the gold medal in the 48-kg category at the Russian Moscow Stars International Wushu Championship 2024.

□ PM Narendra Modi inaugurates Sela Tunnel project

- **Prime Minister Narendra Modi** virtually inaugurated the **Sela Tunnel project** from **Itanagar** on Saturday, marking a significant milestone in the infrastructure development of Arunachal Pradesh.
- The Sela Tunnel, located in the **West Kameng District**, has been constructed at a cost of **Rs 825 crore**, connecting **Tezpur** and **Tawang**.
- Sela Tunnel, situated at an **altitude** of **13000 feet**, bypasses the treacherous Sela Pass at an altitude of 13700 feet.
- The Balipara-Charduar-Tawang Road, where the tunnel is located, serves as a vital axis connecting the Tawang Region and provides essential connectivity up to Tezpur.
- Overcoming various bottlenecks such as Nichephu, Bomdila Town, and Sela Pass, the tunnel project, along with Nechiphu Tunnel, addresses critical infrastructure needs.





Sela Tunnel

- The **foundation stone** of the Sela Tunnel was laid by **Prime Minister Modi** on **February 9, 2019**, and **construction commenced** on **April 1, 2019**.
- Despite facing challenges posed by difficult terrain and adverse weather conditions, the tunnel has been completed in just five years.
- Sela Tunnel, situated at an **altitude** of **13000 feet**, bypasses the treacherous **Sela Pass** at an altitude of **13700 feet**.
- The **Balipara-Charduar-Tawang Road**, where the tunnel is located, serves as a vital axis **connecting** the **Tawang Region** and provides essential connectivity up to **Tezpur**.
- The **Sela Tunnel System** comprises **two tunnels** with **lengths** of **1003 meters** and **1595 meters**, along with **8.6 kilometers** of approach and link roads.
- Additionally, the second tunnel features an escape tube adjacent to the main tunnel to facilitate emergency situations, meeting international safety standards.
- Designed for a traffic density of 3000 cars and 2000 trucks per day, the tunnel is expected to enhance all-weather connectivity to Tawang and reinforce defense capabilities in the region.
- Constructed using the New Austrian Tunneling Method (NATM), widely recognised for its effectiveness in Himalayan geology, the Sela Tunnel Project employed over 90 lakh man-hours and utilised significant quantities of cement, steel, and explosives.
- Despite facing challenges such as freezing temperatures, water ingress, and the impact of COVID-19, the Border Roads Organisation (BRO) successfully completed the project ahead of schedule.





□ Arunachal gets 8 new highway packages worth Rs 6621.62 crore

- The Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways, Nitin Gadkari, has given clearance for constructing eight packages on the National Highway-913 in Arunachal Pradesh.
- The **funding amount** for the project is estimated at **Rs. 6621.62 crore**.
- *The Frontier Highway*, as it is called, will span a **total length** of **265.49 km**, making it easier to connect the border areas.
- The project aims to improve the connectivity of the state and promote socioeconomic growth.
- The Minister said that the constriction of the Frontier Highway will help in curbing migration and facilitate reverse migration towards the border areas of Arunachal Pradesh.
- The packages include the Huri-Taliha section, the Bile-Migging Section, the Kharsang-Maio-Gandhigram-Vijaynagar section, and the Bomdila-Nafra-Lada section.




□ Arunachal star Millo Sunka bags award at Critics Choice Awards

- Arunachalee actress Millo Sunka has once again made her mark by winning the 'Best Actress Award' at the annual Critics Choice Awards-2024 held in Mumbai on Tuesday.
- The Critics Choice Awards recognise excellence in films, web, and short films in India.
- Hailing from Hapoli in the Lower Subansiri district, Millo Sunka was awarded the Best Actress Award for her role in the short film "Nocturnal Burger," a 28-minute film that received the **Best Director and Best Short Film awards** at the event.

Report on Arunachal's endangered languages submitted to NEC

- The North Eastern Council-funded Research Project titled, "Documentation of Endangered Languages, Oral Narratives, and Cultures of the Lesser-Known Tribal Communities of Arunachal Pradesh" has been successfully completed and submitted to the NEC, Shillong by the Centre for Endangered Languages (CFEL), Rajiv Gandhi University (RGU).
- Three lesser-known communities of the state namely Ashing (Adi) of Upper Siang, Nah (Tagin) of Upper Subansiri, and Brokpa (Monpa) of West Kameng districts were extensively studied under this project.
- The tangible research outputs of this project are the five published books including two monographs and three bilingual dictionaries namely Ethnographic Profile of the Brokpa (Monpa) of Arunachal Pradesh (2023), Ethnographic Profile of the Nah (Tagin) of Arunachal Pradesh (2023), A Dictionary of Nah (2023), Brokpa-English Dictionary (2023) and Dictionary and Grammar of Ashing: A Moribund Language of Arunachal Pradesh (2022).





□ Arunachal gets first-of-its kind fish museum in Ziro

- Arunachal Chief Minister Pema Khandu announced on Thursday the inauguration of the **first-of-its-kind fish museum** in **Ziro**.
- In 2022, Arunachal Fisheries Minister Tage Taki announced the plans for a fish museum, the first of its kind in the Northeast.
- The fish museum is part of India's first-ever 'Integrated Aqua Park' which has been approved by the central government and is set up at Tarin (Ziro) in the Lower Subansiri district.
- In **2019**, **Prime Minister Narendra Modi** announced one Integrated Aqua Park for each state and Union Territory under the **Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana** to bring the blue revolution.

☐ Arunachal gets oil palm processing unit

- In a significant development for India's agricultural sector, 3F Oil Palm, one of the country's largest Oil Palm development companies, has initiated commercial operations at *India's first integrated Oil Palm Processing Unit* in Arunachal Pradesh.
- Situated in Roing, the headquarters of the Lower Dibang Valley district, this unit marks a crucial step towards achieving self-reliance in edible oils, driven by the National Mission on Edible Oils Oil Palm (NMEO-OP).





ASSAM

- **☐** World Bank approves \$452 million assistance for Assam
 - The World Bank's Board of Executive Directors have approved the single largest state-specific operation in Assam till date amounting to \$452 million which aims to strengthen the resilience and management of roads and bridges to help people living in 1,739 villages gain round-the-year access to wholesale markets, schools, hospitals, and places of work.
- The program Assam Resilient Rural Bridges Program aims to improve connectivity for over 1.8 million people living in rural areas, especially during extreme weather.
- The **total project cost** is **564.71 million** of which the Bank is giving **\$452 million**.
- The **assistance** is restricted to **improving 1184 bridges** on the rural roads network "**rural bridges**", whilst building the road and bridge management capability of the Assam Public Works Department.
- ☐ Majuli mask craft, manuscript painting secure coveted GI tag
 - In a significant achievement for cultural preservation, Majuli's mask craft, known as Mukha Shilpa, and manuscript painting have received the prestigious Geographical Indication (GI) tag.
- The approval follows a comprehensive examination of the deep cultural wealth and historical significance inherent in these traditional folk crafts.



☐ 'Mera pehla vote' campaign launched to encourage youth to vote

- The **Ministry of Education** has taken an initiative **to promote voter awareness** among young voters across the country.
- The initiative is titled 'Mera Pehla Vote Desh Ke Live'.
- The campaign aims to ensure universal participation of youth in the elections.
- Students of Arya Vidyapeeth College took a pledge to cast their vote during the campaign.

□ IIT Guwahati inks MoUs with coveted institutes of Canada and Japan

- Indian Institute of Technology Guwahati (IIT Guwahati) has signed Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) with Dalhousie University, Canada, and Gifu University, Japan, aimed at fostering knowledge exchange and academic enrichment.
- These **MoUs** signed for **five years** with possibilities of extension, mark a significant stride towards promoting cross-cultural learning and research collaboration.
- Prof. Rajeev Ahuja, Officiating Director of IIT Guwahati, expressed pride in these partnerships, emphasizing the institute's commitment to nurturing students' academic and personal growth through international collaborations.

□ Kodomi & Tutula, the mascots for Kamrup's LS Elections

- The **election mascots** of the upcoming **Lok Sabha Elections** in **Kamrup Metropolitan District** were unveiled on March 9.
- The two 'hargila' birds named *Kodomi* and *Tutula* are a pair of birds that represent the endangered **Greater Adjutant Stork**.
- The launch of the election mascots took place on the same day as the launch of the **Systematic Voters' Education and Electoral Participation (SVEEP) programme**.

□ Assam introduces *Meitei script* in edu institutes

- The **Assam Cabinet** has given its nod to the **introduction** of the **Meitei** or **Manipuri Mayek** script in the **educational institutions of the state**.
- This decision, reached during the recent cabinet meeting, aims to provide students with the opportunity to engage with Manipuri literature and pursue higher studies in Manipuri using the Meitei or Mayek script.

□ Latest survey finds Golden Langur population stands at 7,396 in India

- A survey conducted by reputed organizations found that the total population of Golden Langurs stands at 7,396 who cohabit in 707 groups, a news report published in the Hindu said quoting the findings of the survey.
- The survey was a joint effort led by the *Primate Research Centre NE India* (PRCNE), Assam Forest Department, Bodoland Territorial Council, Salim Ali Centre for Ornithology and Natural History (SACON), and Conservation Himalayas.






☐ Tata's semiconductor plant in Assam

- In a historic move, Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation for the Tata Semiconductor Assembly and Test Pvt Ltd (TSAT) unit in Morigaon, Assam.
- This marks a significant stride towards India's technological self-sufficiency and global prominence in the semiconductor industry.
- The ambitious project, with a staggering capacity of producing 48 million chips daily, aims to reshape India's tech landscape and contribute to the nation's "Atmanirbhar Bharat" initiative.

□ Pobitora Wildlife Sanctuary

- **Pobitora National Park** is situated in the **Morigaon district** of the state of Assam.
- The national park is located about 48 km by from Guwahati.
- It has a dense population of the **Great Indian one-horned rhinoceros**.
- It covers 38.8 km2.
- Though the total notified area of the park is 38.80 square kms, only 16 square kms is the effective rhino habitat.
- Pobitora was declared a reserved forest in 1971 and a wildlife sanctuary in 1987.
- It covers **flat flood plains** and a **hillock** (**Raja Mayong**).
- Pobitora is mainly famous for its great Indian One-horned rhinoceros.
- Besides rhinoceros, the other animals are leopard, wild boar, Barking deer, wild buffalo etc.
- Assam's Pobitora Wildlife Sanctuary is also home to more than 2000 migratory birds and various reptiles. - It is also an Important Bird Area. ne Stop Destination for Aspiring Officers
- In Pobitora wildlife sanctuary, there are now around 93 rhinos, a ten per cent increase over the last six years.
- These 93 rhinos are surviving on merely 16 square km area of the park.

 Guwahati Ring Road to pass through Amchang Wildlife Sanctuary
- The Standing Committee of National Board for Wildlife (NBWL) has given wildlife clearance to Guwahati Ring Road in Assam, a small portion of which would go through the Amchang Wildlife Sanctuary in the city.
- A total of 7.12 hectares of forest land in Amchang Wildlife Sanctuary and 44.60 hectares of non-forest land in ESZ of Amchang Wildlife Sanctuary would be used for the construction of the Guwahati Ring Road including a bridge over Brahmaputra River (Northern Bypass from Baihata to Sonapur).



□IIT Guwahati makes huge breakthrough in decoding human brain

- esearchers at Indian Institute of Technology, Guwahati seem to have developed a novel algorithm, *Unique Brain Network Identification Number (UBNIN)*, designed to encode the intricate brain networks of healthy humans and patients with Parkinson's disease (PD).
- "UBNIN is a special number representing unique characteristics of the human brain from a network perspective. Interestingly, it can also reverse engineer any human's UBNIN value to reconstruct the original brain network. This UBNIN algorithm will enable us to identify and characterize(encode-decode) brain networks of every human being efficiently."
- This study involved the analysis of structural brain MRI scans of 180 PD patients and 70 healthy individuals from the National Institute of Mental Health and Neurosciences (NIMHANS), India.

□ Krisarthak selected by World Summit Awards

□ IIT Guwahati transfers breakthrough swine fever vaccine technology

- In a groundbreaking development, the **Indian Institute of Technology Guwahati** has successfully transferred pioneering **vaccine technology** to **BioMed Pvt. Ltd**.
- This technology marks a milestone in India's vaccine landscape, offering a solution to combat the classical swine fever virus in pigs and wild boars.
- The first-of-its-kind recombinant vector vaccine for pigs, developed through a reverse genetic platform at IIT Guwahati, promises to address the severe threat posed by swine fever.
- Although not transmissible to humans, swine fever has a high mortality rate among pigs and has been a persistent challenge in India, particularly in northeastern states and regions like Bihar, Kerala, Punjab, Haryana, and Gujarat. estination for Aspiring Officers

- She has secured a contract with Metro United WFC in the South Australian Women's National Premier League.
- She joins the ranks of *Jyoti Chauhan, Kiran Pisda*, and *M. K. Kashmina* as the fourth player to secure a contract abroad out of the 27 participants in the trials.

Researchers discover stunning new cicada species

- Scientists have uncovered a dazzling **new cicada species** known colloquially as "Butterfly Cicadas" from Meghalaya hinting at a tale of evolution yet untold.
- The cicada belonging to the genus **Becquartina**, marks the **first-ever record** of this genus in **India**.
- The genus *Becquartina* is reported for the **first time from India** with a new species, *Becquartina bicolor* from **Meghalaya**.
- Researchers associated with the study say that based on its appearance, the name 'Bicolor Butterfly Cicada' seems appropriate for this species
- The cicada was **first found** in and around the **plateau** of **Balpakram National Park** of **South Garo Hills District** of **Meghalaya state** in the year **2017**.
- Later in **2020**, the species was **recorded** from **Nongkhrah community forest** near **Nongpoh** in the **Ri Bhoi district** of Meghalaya.



MIZORAM

□ Baryl Vanneihsangi becomes first female Assembly Speaker

- In a groundbreaking move, the Mizoram Legislative Assembly witnessed history on Thursday afternoon as Member of Legislative Assembly (MLA) Baryl Vanneihsangi took the Speaker's seat, marking the first time a woman has assumed this pivotal role in the state's legislative history.
- Baryl Vanneihsangi is not only Mizoram's youngest female MLA but also one of the youngest in the current legislative session alongside Indian footballer Jeje Lalpekhlua.

□Nirupam Chakma appointed as Member of National Commission for ST

- Nirupam Chakma, a politician from Mizoram, has been appointed as a Member of the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes (NCST).
- The official announcement came on Saturday, following a letter of notification issued by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India.
- Nirupam Chakma, a seasoned political figure, has an impressive background in Mizoram politics.
- Elected five times as a Member of the Mizoram Legislative Assembly, he has also served
- as the Minister of State for a decade.

 In 2020, he added another feather to his cap by being elected as the National Council Member of BJP Mizoram Pradesh.





□ New orchid species in Mizoram named after local wildlife scientist

- A new orchid species *Bulbophyllum gopalianum* (*Gopal's Bulbophyllum*) was found by Mal Sâwmliana from the Lurh area in Champhai which is situated on the easternmost fringes of the Indo-Myanmar Biodiversity Hotspot.
- The discovery of the new orchid species has been published in The Nordic Journal of Botany.
- Mal Sâwmliana, a forest conservator in the Champhai area in Mizoram routinely embarks on botanical trips to discover and document interesting plant species.
- This time it was lucky for him as he found an orchid species which was a new orchid species.
- The species has been named after Gopal Singh Rawat, former Director and Dean of the Faculty of Wildlife Sciences at the Wildlife Institute of India, for his significant contributions to ecology and taxonomy in India.

☐ Mizoram athlete clinches world title in Thai Martial Arts

- Mizoram athlete Joseph Vanlalhruaia has etched his name in history by becoming the first Indian to secure the WMO World Title in the 51 KG category at the esteemed 6th International Thai Martial Arts Games held in Pattaya, Thailand.
- Joseph's remarkable triumph not only marks a significant personal milestone but also highlights India's prowess in the domain of martial arts.




☐ Work begins on longest tunnel in Dimapur–Kohima rail link

- In a significant leap forward, construction activities have commenced at Portal 1 of Tunnel No 7 for the Dimapur Kohima New Rail Line Project, situated in Tsiepama village of Medziphema circle in Dimapur district, Nagaland.
- This tunnel is slated to be the **longest one** within the **Dimapur Kohima New** Rail Line Project.
- Positioned between **Pherima** and **Piphema stations**, this tunnel **aims to enhance connectivity and accessibility in the region**.
- The Dimapur Kohima New Rail Line Project, covering a **total length** of **82.50 kilometers** (**2.75 kilometers** in **Assam** and **79.75 kilometers** in **Nagaland**), is estimated to **cost Rs. 6,663 crore**.
- With eight new stations, namely Dhansiri, Dhansiripar, Shokhuvi, Molvom, Pherima, Piphema, Menguzuma, and Zubza, the project also encompasses 27 major bridges, 148 minor bridges, five Road Over Bridges, 15 Road Under Bridges, and 21 Tunnels spanning 31 kilometers in length.


