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

Colombo Process

- The **Colombo Process comprises 12 Asian member states** and serves as a regional consultative forum. It aims to promote the sharing of best practices related to overseas employment for **countries in South and Southeast Asia** that send **migrant workers** abroad.
- The 12 member states include Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Nepal, Pakistan, the Philippines, Sri Lanka, Thailand, and Vietnam.
 - **The founding states include** Bangladesh, China, India, Indonesia, Nepal, Pakistan, the Philippines, Sri Lanka, Thailand, and Vietnam.
 - In the past, it has been **chaired by** Afghanistan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, the **Philippines, Indonesia**, and Bangladesh.
- The **decisions** under Colombo Process are made by **consensus** and are **non-binding**.

In July 1995, approximately 8,000 Muslims, mostly men and boys were killed in Srebrenica, a town in Bosnia and Herzegovina in southeastern Europe, by Bosnian Serb forces led by Commander Ratko Mladić. These killings were later classified as genocide by international tribunals investigating the massacre.

The disintegration of Yugoslavia in 1991 threw the southeastern and central Europe in chaos and led to violent inter-ethnic wars in the region over the next few years. In many ways, the violence perpetrated against Bosniaks or Bosnian Muslims during the Srebrenica massacre was a result of this regional conflict. According to some researchers, this massacre was the worst atrocity against civilians in Europe since the Holocaust.

LignoSat

- LignoSat, a fusion of "ligno" (the Latin word for wood) and "satellite",.
- It is developed through collaborative research and development by a team comprising members from **Kyoto University and Sumitomo Forestry Co.**
- **Objective:** Their objective is to leverage the **eco-friendliness** and cost-effectiveness of wood in space exploration.
- It is constructed from **magnolia wood**, chosen for its durability and adaptability.
- **Why is wood used?** : Wooden satellites are viewed as **more environmentally friendly** upon reentering the Earth's atmosphere at the conclusion of their mission. Unlike metal satellites, which pose air pollution risks due to the generation of metal particles during reentry, wooden satellites mitigate these concerns.
- It will first be sent to the **International Space Station (ISS)** aboard a **SpaceX rocket** from the Kennedy Space Center.

- It is a **family of funds dedicated to confronting biodiversity loss, climate change, pollution, and strains on land and ocean health.**
- Its secretariat is based in Washington, D.C.
- It provides **Financial Assistance for five major International Conventions:**
 - The [Minamata Convention](#) on Mercury (signed in 2013 and entered into force in 2017).
 - The [Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants](#) (POPs) (adopted in 2001 and entered into force in 2004).
 - The [United Nations Convention on Biological Diversity \(UNCBD\)](#) (entered into force in 1993).
 - The [United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification \(UNCCD\)](#) (adopted in 1994).
 - The [United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change \(UNFCCC\)](#) (signed in 1992 and entered into force in 1994).

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United Nations Development Programme (UNDP)

- The UNDP is a United Nations agency tasked with **helping countries eliminate poverty and achieve sustainable economic growth and human development.**
- The UNDP was **established in 1965 by the United Nations General Assembly**, and became **operational in January 1966.**
- UNDP's work is concentrated in **three focus areas** –
 - Sustainable development,
 - Democratic governance and peace building, and
 - Climate and disaster resilience.
- **Mission & Vision** –
 - UNDP's mandate is to end poverty, build democratic governance, rule of law, and inclusive institutions.
 - It advocates for change, and connect countries to knowledge, experience and resources to help people build a better life.
- **Funding** – It is funded entirely by voluntary contributions from member nations.
- **Headquarters** – New York, USA

- As of March 2024, the RBI's total gold reserves stand at 822.10 metric tonnes. A substantial part of the precious commodity is stored abroad. India also had its holding with the Bank of England like other countries.
- The movement of 100 metric tonnes into India has taken the overall quantity stored locally to over 408 metric tonnes of gold, which means the local and foreign holding is now split almost evenly.

Why does RBI store its gold abroad?

- Historically, during the 1990-91 foreign exchange crisis, India pledged part of its gold reserves to the Bank of England to secure a \$405 million loan. Although the loan was repaid by November 1991, the RBI chose to keep the gold in the UK for logistical reasons. Gold stored abroad can be easily used for trading, entering into swaps, and earning returns. The RBI also buys gold from international markets and storing it overseas facilitates these transactions.
- Storing gold internationally comes with risks, particularly during geopolitical tensions. The freezing of Russian assets by Western nations has heightened concerns about the safety of assets held abroad. The RBI's recent move to repatriate gold from the UK likely reflects these concerns.

Blue Planet Prize

- It was established in 1992, the year of the [Rio Earth Summit](#).
- This award is given annually by **Japan's Asahi Glass Foundation** for **outstanding achievements in scientific research** and its application which have helped to solve **global environmental problems**.

- He said, in this Lok Sabha polls, 31.2 crore women voters cast their votes which is also the highest ever in the world.
- He also said, only 39 repolling were conducted in this election unlike 540 repolling in 2019 General Election. Mr Kumar said, over 68 thousand monitoring teams and 1.5 crore polling and security personnel were involved in the electoral exercise.

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

State of Menstrual Leaves in India

- **Menstrual (Period) Leave:** It is a kind of leave where the **working women have the option to avail either paid or unpaid leave** from the institution of her employment during her period of menstruation as such a condition adversely affects her ability to work .
- Implemented the Policy: Bihar and Kerala are the only Indian states that have introduced menstrual leave policies for women.
 - **Bihar's policy was introduced in 1992**, allowing women employees two days of paid menstrual leave every month.
 - **Kerala** in 2023 has also allowed menstrual leave to female students of all universities and institutions and up to 60 days maternity leave to female students above the age of 18.
 - Some companies in India have introduced [menstrual leave policies](#), including **Zomato**, which announced a **10-day paid period leave per year in 2020**.
 - Other companies, such as **Swiggy and Byjus**, have also followed suit.

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Why is there a Need for Paid Menstrual Leave for Women?

- **Health and Well-being:** Menstruation can cause **physical discomfort (cramps, bloating)** and emotional distress. **Paid leave allows women to prioritise their health** and manage these symptoms without financial penalty.
- **Workplace Inclusivity and Gender Gap:** This leave will normalise menstruation, reducing stigma and encouraging open discussion about menstrual health. Its impact on work performance helps address the gender pay gap by enabling women to fully participate in the workforce without sacrificing income.
- **Productivity and Retention:** Studies suggest that **menstrual leave can improve productivity** by allowing women to manage their periods effectively and avoid working while experiencing discomfort. It can also **contribute to higher employee retention**.
 - As per [IMF](#), equal participation of women in the workforce will increase India's [GDP](#) by 27% and will add **USD 700 billion to its GDP by 2025**. Thus **economic growth and gender equality go hand in hand**.
- **Legal Perspectives:**
 - **Article 15(3):** Permits **special provisions for women**, countering claims of discrimination against men who can't avail menstrual leave.
 - **Article 42:** Mandates the state to ensure **"just and humane conditions of work"** and **"maternity relief."** Menstrual leave is seen as an extension of this responsibility, promoting a humane work environment for women during menstruation.

UN Global Supply Chain Forum

- It was the **inaugural edition** of the forum, which was held from May 21 to 24, 2024, in Barbados.
- It was **hosted by UN Trade and Development (UNCTAD)** in collaboration with the **Government of Barbados**.
- Over 1,000 participants from around the world convened to **tackle the pressing issues of global disruptions, geopolitical tensions, climate change, and the COVID-19 pandemic and their impact on global trade**.
 - It gathered key figures, **including trade and transport Ministers** from several small island developing states (SIDS).
 - **Representatives from various UN agencies ,major ports like the Port of Seattle, and industry leaders in shipping and logistics** were also present.
- The forum underscored the complexities and opportunities in **decarbonizing global shipping**, with a particular focus on developing countries rich in renewable energy resources.
- Efforts to **incentivize low- or zero-carbon fuels**, establish **safety frameworks for new fuels**, and **enhance port readiness** for handling various fuels were **identified as critical steps** in driving sustainable freight transport and logistics.
- One of the major outcomes of the forum was the **launch of the "Manifesto for Intermodal, Low-Carbon, Efficient and Resilient Freight Transport and Logistics."**
 - This manifesto calls for a significant transformation in freight transport to achieve global climate targets and improve socio-economic resilience, emphasizing the transition to zero-emission fuels, optimized logistics, and sustainable value chains.

Ahilya Bai Holkar

- Maharani Ahilyabai Holkar (31 May 1725 – 13 August 1795) was the Holkar Queen of the Maratha Malwa kingdom, India.
- Ahilyabai's husband, **Khanderao Holkar**, was killed in the battle of Kumbher in 1754.
- Twelve years later, her father-in-law, **Malhar Rao Holkar**, died.
- A year after that, she was crowned the **queen** of Malwa kingdom. For the next 28 years, Ahilyabai ruled over Malwa in a just, wise, and knowledgeable manner.
- Under Ahilyabai's rule, Malwa enjoyed **relative peace, prosperity, and stability**, and her capital, Maheshwar, was turned into an oasis of literary, musical, artistic, and industrial pursuits.
 - She welcomed stalwarts such as Marathi poet **Moropant**, **Shahir Ananta Gandhi**, and Sanskrit scholar **Khushali Ram** into her capital.
- She was instrumental in **spreading the message of dharma** and propagating industrialization.
- She established a **textile industry** in Maheshwar, which today is very famous for its Maheshwari sarees.
- She was a great **pioneer and builder of Hindu temples**.
 - She built hundreds of temples and Dharmashalas throughout India.
 - Her most **notable contribution** was the renovation and repair of the famous **Kashi Vishwanath Temple** in 1780.
- She also made some **landmark decisions** during her reign, including the removal of traditional law confiscating the property of childless widows.
- **John Keay**, the British historian, gave the queen the title of 'The Philosopher Queen'.
- She passed away on August 13, 1795, at the age of seventy.

UNESCO Creative Cities Network

- UNESCO Creative Cities Network (UCCN) was created in 2004.
- The network covers seven creative fields namely **Crafts and Folk Art, Design, Film, Gastronomy, Literature, Media Arts and Music**.
- The **annual conference of mayors and other stakeholders** of network cities offers a unique occasion to **strengthen ties between creative cities** from across the world.
- In 2024, the conference will be held in **July in Braga, Portugal**.

Objective

- In 2024, **350 cities** make up this network which aims towards a common objective of placing **creativity and cultural industries** at the heart of their development plans at the local level and cooperating actively at the international level.

- Srinagar has become the **fourth Indian city** to be recognised as a 'World Crafts City' by the **World Craft Council (WCC)**.
- **Jaipur, Malappuram and Mysore** are the other three Indian cities that have earlier been recognised as **World Craft Cities**.
- In 2021, Srinagar city was designated a **creative city** as part of the [UNESCO Creative City Network \(UCCN\)](#) for crafts and folk arts.
- **Papier-maché, walnut wood carving, carpets, Sozni embroidery and Pashmina and Kani shawls** are some of the crafts from Srinagar.

WCC-World Craft City Programme

- It was launched in 2014 by the **World Crafts Council AISBL (WCC-International)** to recognise the pivotal role **local authorities, craftspeople, and communities** play in **crafts development across the world**.

- Recently, the [Indian Space Research Organisation \(ISRO\)](#) successfully completed the third and final [Reusable Launch Vehicle Landing Experiment \(RLV LEX-03\)](#) for the **Pushpak vehicle**.
- This demonstrated the autonomous landing capability of the RLV under more challenging release conditions and severe wind conditions.

RLV LEX-03 Mission

- During the RLV LEX-03 mission, the **Pushpak vehicle** was released from an **Indian Air Force Chinook helicopter** at an altitude of 4.5 km.
- From this point, the winged vehicle autonomously executed cross-range correction manoeuvres approached the runway and performed a precise horizontal landing at the runway centerline.
- The high-speed landing, exceeding 320 km/h, was successfully slowed to around 100 km/h using the vehicle's brake parachute and landing gear brakes.

- Recently, the **central government** notified certain sections of the [Telecommunications Act of 2023](#).
- It aims to **update and unify telecom laws**, by replacing outdated laws like the [Indian Telegraph Act of 1885](#), the [Indian Wireless Telegraph Act, 1933](#) and [Telegraph Wires \(Unlawful Possession\) Act, 1950](#).

Salient Features of the Telecommunications Act 2023

- Definitions:** The Act clearly defines its scope, **thereby reducing uncertainties**.
 - Messages sent through internet-based messaging service providers such as WhatsApp, Signal, and Telegram, as well as those that are encrypted (except Over-the-Top (OTT) services), are within the Act's ambit.
- Right of Way (RoW) Framework:** The Act provides an effective RoW framework, **both on public and private property**.
 - The definition of public entities has been **broadened to include government agencies**, local bodies, and PPP projects like airports, seaports, and highways.
 - Public entities shall be obligated to provide right of way except in special circumstances.

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- Common Ducts:** In line with [PM Gati Shakti's vision](#), the law provides for the Central Government to establish common ducts and cable corridors.
- National Security Measures:** Section 20 (2) of the Act allows the government to **stop the transmission of any message** in the interest of public safety and during a public emergency.
 - This majorly expands the number of government entities that may be able to intercept messages.
- Digital Bharat Nidhi:** With the new Act, the [Universal Service Obligation Fund \(USOF\)](#) will become **Digital Bharat Nidhi**, which can be used to fund research and development and pilot projects instead of just supporting the establishment of telecom services in rural areas.
 - The Act also provides a legal framework for [Regulatory Sandbox](#) to facilitate innovation and deployment of new technology.
- Protection of Users:** Commercial messages sent without the user's consent may lead to the relevant operator facing a fine and being banned from providing services.
 - Establishing **Do Not Disturb registers has been made mandatory** for operators.
 - Having more than 9 SIM cards will attract fines up to Rs 2 lakh.** The limit is being reduced to six for residents of Jammu and Kashmir and the Northeast.

Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban

- **Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban (SBM-U)** was launched on October 2, 2014, by the **Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs** as a national campaign to promote cleanliness, sanitation, and proper waste management in urban areas.
- It aimed to make cities and towns across India clean and free from open defecation.

Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban 1.0:

- The first phase of SBM-U focused on **achieving the target of making urban India ODF** by providing access to toilets and promoting behavioral change.
- SBM-U 1.0 was successful in achieving the target and **100% of urban India was declared ODF.**

Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban 2.0 (2021-2026):

- SBM-U 2.0, announced in Budget 2021-22, is the continuation of **SBM-U first phase.**
- The second phase of SBM-U aimed to **go beyond ODF to ODF+, and ODF++**, and focus on making urban India **garbage-free.**
- It emphasized **sustainable sanitation practices, waste management, and the promotion of a circular economy.**

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Open Defecation Free Status

- **ODF:** An area can be notified or declared as ODF if at any point of the day, not even a single person is found defecating in the open.
- **ODF+:** This status is given if at any point of the day, not a single person is found defecating and/or urinating in the open, and all community and public toilets are functional and well maintained.
- **ODF++:** This status is given if the area is already ODF+ and the faecal sludge/septage and sewage are safely managed and treated, with no discharging or dumping of untreated faecal sludge and sewage into the open drains, water bodies or areas.

National Monetisation Pipeline (NMP)

- The NMP envisages an **aggregate monetisation potential of Rs 6-lakh crore through the leasing of core assets of the Central government** in sectors such as roads, railways, power, oil and gas pipelines, telecom, civil aviation etc, over a **four-year period (FY 2022-25)**.
- The **Monetization through NMP only includes core assets**, excluding monetization through **disinvestment of non-core assets**. Currently, only assets of **central government line ministries and CPSEs** in infrastructure sectors have been **included**.
- The government is currently in the process of coordinating and collating asset pipelines from states to expand the scope of the NMP, **incorporating assets at both the central and state levels in due course**.

National Green Hydrogen Mission (NGHM)

- India launched the **National Green Hydrogen Mission (NGHM)** in January 2023.
- The **Ministry of New & Renewable Energy (MNRE)** is implementing the NGHM with a target to achieve a **production capacity of 5 million tonnes per annum of Green Hydrogen in the country by the year 2030**.
- The **Strategic Interventions for Green Hydrogen Transition (SIGHT)** programme, under NGHM, provides incentives for the manufacturing of **electrolysers and the production of green ammonia**.

Green Ammonia

- **Ammonia** is a chemical that is used mainly in the **manufacture of nitrogenous fertilisers**, like urea and ammonium nitrate, but can be put to other uses too, such as to run engines.
- Green ammonia production is where the process of making ammonia is **100% renewable and carbon-free**.

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HYDROGEN AND GREEN HYDROGEN

Hydrogen is the most common element in nature but exists only in combination with other elements. It has to be extracted from naturally occurring compounds (like water).

Green Hydrogen (GH₂) is made by splitting water through an electrical process called electrolysis, using an electrolyser powered by renewable energy (RE).

The diagram shows three processes for hydrogen production:

- Grey hydrogen:** Natural gas is processed to produce hydrogen, with CO₂ emissions shown as a byproduct.
- Blue hydrogen:** Natural gas is processed to produce hydrogen, with CO₂ captured and stored underground.
- Green hydrogen:** Water is split into hydrogen and oxygen using green electricity.

BHARATIYA NAGARIK SURAKSHA SANHITA (BNSS), 2023

BNSS replaces CrPc 1973 and consists of 521 sections with 177 sections revised, 9 new sections added, and 14 sections repealed.

Key Provisions

- Hierarchy of Courts: Eliminated distinction and role of Metropolitan Magistrates
- Mandated Use of Electronic Mode: At stages of investigation, inquiry, and trial
- Detention of Undertrials: Restriction on release on seasonal bonds for accused persons (b) charged with life imprisonment or (c) facing multiple proceedings
- Alternative to Arrest: An accused doesn't have to be arrested; instead, the police can take a security bond for their appearance before a Judicial Magistrate
- Community Service Defined: Work which the Court may order a convict to perform as a form of punishment that benefits the community, for which he shall not be entitled to any remuneration
- Substitution of Terminology: "Marital Status" replaced by "soundness of mind" in majority of provisions
- Documentation Protocols: Searches with/without warrants require mandatory police-initiated documentation with recorded material promptly submitted to Magistrate

Key Issues

- Permitted 15 days of police custody within total 45-60 days
- Doesn't mandate investigating officer to provide reasons when seeking police custody
- Allows use of handcuffs during arrests, conducting SC ratings and NHPC guidelines
- Scope of mandators both limited in case of multiple charges
- Limits plea bargaining in India to sentence bargaining
- Restricting bail and limiting scope for plea bargaining could deter decongesting of prisons
- Power to seize property expanded to immovable property apart from movable property
- Several provisions overlap with existing laws
- BNSS retains CrPc provisions related to public order, raising the question of whether governing trial procedure and public order maintenance should be unified or treated separately, considering their distinct functions

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
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
